

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT), in cooperation with the cities of Glendale and Peoria, the Federal Highway Administration and the Maricopa Association of Governments, is holding an online public meeting Feb. 10 to present three alternatives to modify the existing interchange at Loop 101 and 75th Avenue to improve traffic flow by adding a third southbound left turn lane onto eastbound Loop 101. The design alternatives affect 75th Avenue, the eastbound on-ramp at 75th Avenue, the eastbound off-ramp at 67th Avenue, and potentially the eastbound frontage road and right of way between 75th and 67th avenues. Interchange improvements at 75th Avenue will be designed and constructed in conjunction with the planned Loop 101 widening project between 75th Avenue and Interstate 17, which is currently in the design phase. A separate public meeting will be held this spring to present the preliminary design plans for that project.

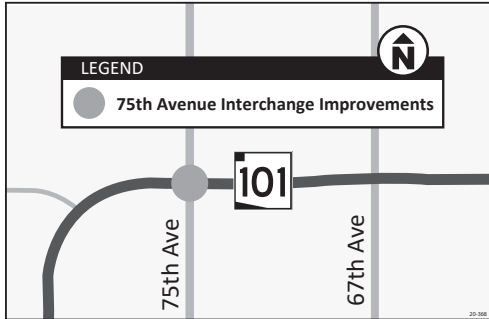
